## Projects Can Apply for County Grants

The Republic County Community Foundation is accepting applications for grant funds.

The RCCF is a collection of funds designed to link donors with charitable causes and is an affiliate of the Greater Salina Community Foundation.

"The RCCF is pleased to take another step toward fulfilling its primary mission: meeting charitable community needs that enhance the quality of life, today and in the future," says William Navis, Belleville, vice-chairman of the board.

Grants are available for projects benefitting and serving Republic County. The RCCF will consider applications from non-profit organizations, individuals and groups of individuals for qualified projects. The application deadline is October 1.

Grants will be financed from the Republic County Community Action Fund, an unrestricted community grant fund. The fund was created by the generosity of those who have contributed to the RCCF since its inception in October 2007. From this endowed fund, the RCCF will award \$4,000 this fall. Additional grant funds will be available in the future as the endowed fund continues to grow.
