Amos & Joyce Blecha 4-H Scholarship

For any Republic County high school seniors who will be attending a post secondary school

Criteria:

- Student in good standing qualifying for graduation from a Republic County high school.
- Student who will be enrolling in post secondary education or vocational school.
- Student involved in extra curricular activities. First consideration given to current 4-H members who have been involved in 4-H for at least 3 years.
- Applicant must complete the Republic County 4-H Scholarship form.
- Selection committee will be the Republic County 4-H Scholarship committee.

Bruce Bowersox Memorial Scholarship

For Republic County High School seniors who will be majoring in Engineering at a post secondary school

Criteria:

- Student in good standing qualifying for graduation from Republic County High School.
- Applicant must attend a two or four-year post high school accredited school.
- Preference toward cumulative grade point average of 3.0 and higher.
- Preference toward a student NOT in the top 2 of class.
- Applicant will be working toward a degree in the field of Engineering.
- Applicant will be full-time student.
- Applicant must provide evidence of financial need, which is to be a determining factor in cases of equal merit.
- Applicant will submit a brief essay about her/his self which explains educational and career goals.
- Applications are due by March 31, and should be sent to the Republic County High School Counselor.
